What is exemplary behavior?

Exemplary behavior is defined as the student having no further incident of misconduct where expulsion, suspension, or an assignment to an alternative setting is required. Students found in violation of local school board policies addressing related behaviors would not qualify for having exemplary behavior.

Does every student qualify for the six-month exemplary behavior review?

A student given a drug-related suspension MUST successfully complete a treatment-counseling program. This is NOT an option if the student wishes to get a Driving Eligibility Certificate after the six-month waiting period. The treatment-counseling program must consist of a minimum of 18 sessions of drug or alcohol treatment counseling, a mental health treatment program, or other appropriate intervention program.
